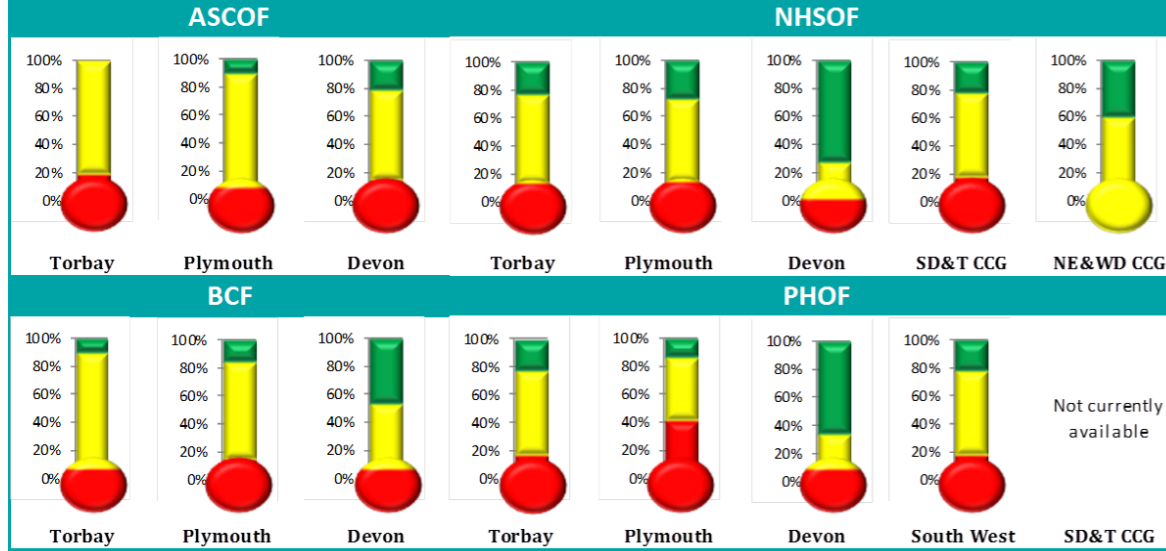


Joint Outcomes Framework Summary - 'Outliers' - April 2015

Summary overview of Outcome Frameworks illustrating the proportion of significance for comparator areas



Introduction

This summary brings together performance 'outliers' for the Adult Social Care Outcomes Framework (ASCOF), Better Care Fund (BCF), National Health Service Outcomes Framework and Clinical Commissioning Group Outcomes Framework (NHSOF, CCGOF) and the Public Health Outcomes Framework (PHOF). Only indicators that were identified as statistically significantly worse than the England average on either an annual basis, or for 3 out of 4 quarters are included in the table below.

The 'Thermometers' represent the proportion of indicators across all frameworks by their significance for comparator areas.

The 'dials' represent the proportion of indicators, that are significantly worse, as a proportion of all outcome framework indicators in each life course.
